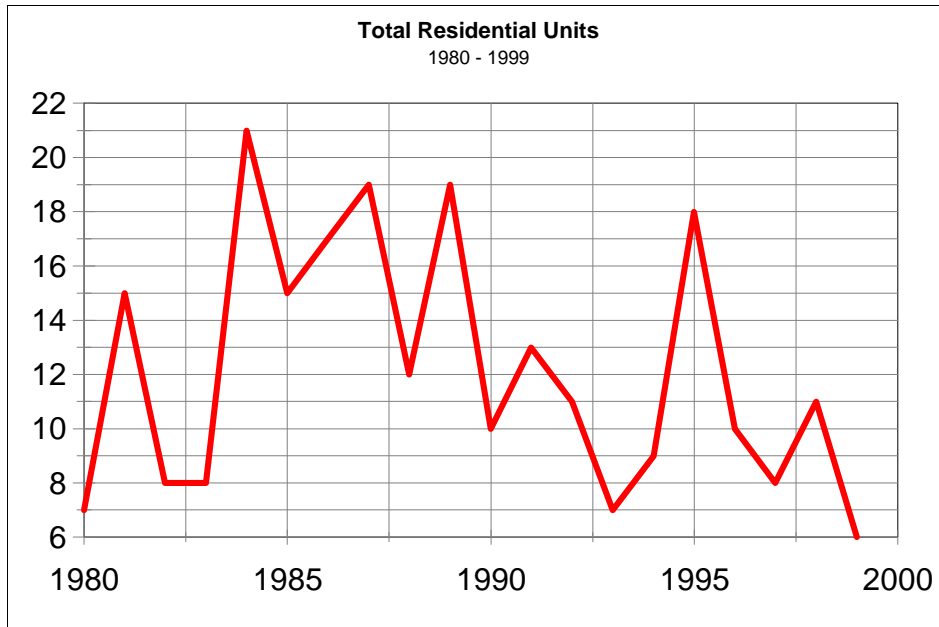
The information contained within this document was compiled from reports issued by the U.S. Bureau of the Census, Construction Statistics Division.

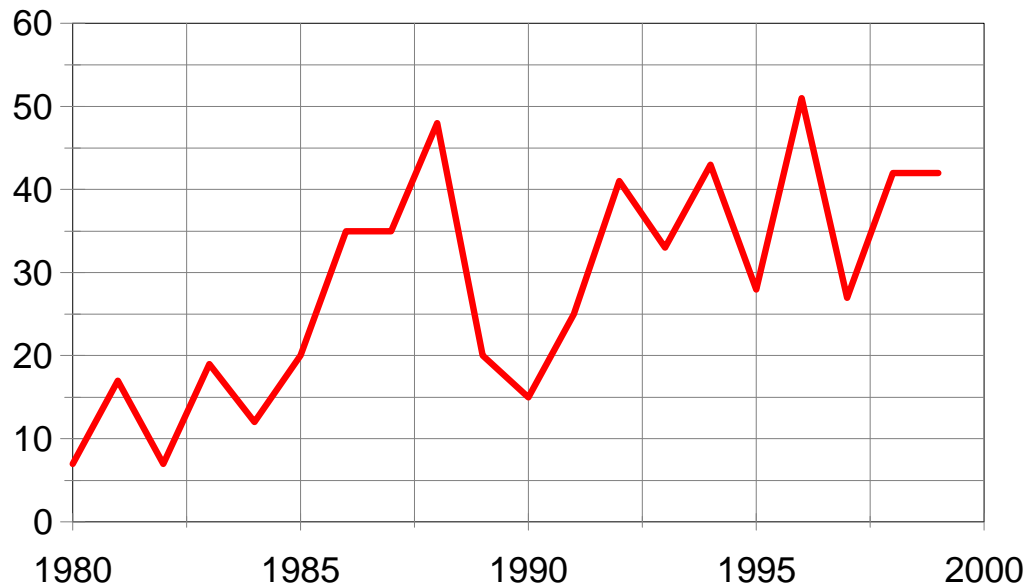

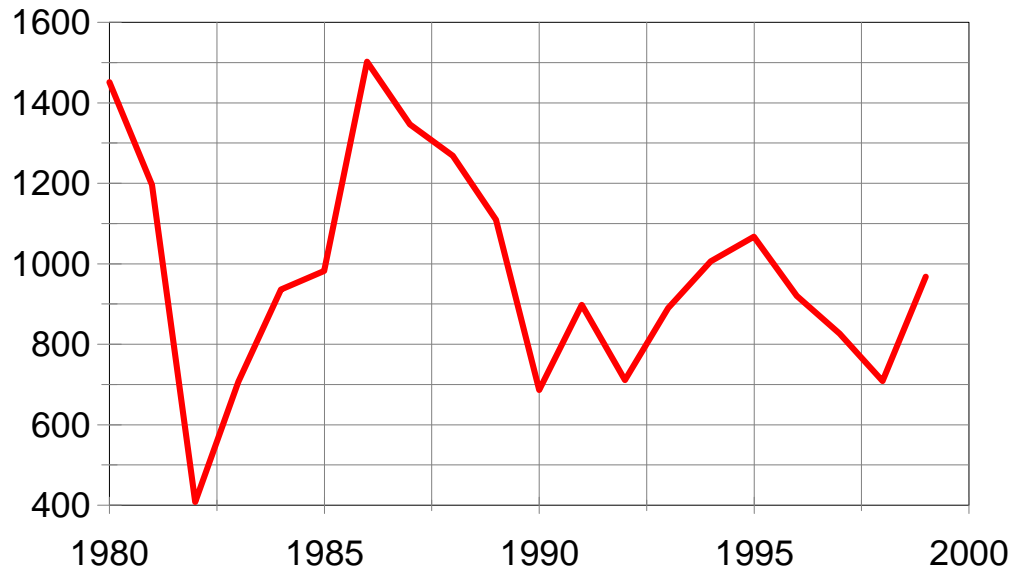
